Day 1

The most immersive way to experience the bustling old city of Pettah is by exploring it on foot. You'll meet your knowledgeable Birdwing Holidays guide, who will lead you on a walking tour through Pettah's lively trading district. Highlights of the area include the Dutch Reformed Church, and a museum dedicated to Dutch influence in Sri Lanka, housed in the 17th-century residence of a former Dutch Governor. After a brief pause for a soft drink at a local café, you'll continue along York Street, passing through colonial landmarks like Cargills in the Fort area. The tour concludes with a stop at the recently restored Dutch Hospital, Colombo's oldest surviving building, where you can relax with a drink or meal at one of the many outstanding restaurants or cafés.

Day 2,3 - Wilpattu National Park

Arrive in Wilpattu National Park and check into Epic wild lodge to experience Sri Lanka's rich biodiversity and wildlife. Witness the rare Sri Lankan leopards, which are known for having one of the highest population densities in the world. Full day safari in the park allows you to explore lush landscapes, diverse flora and fauna, and enjoy guided tours to spot various wildlife species.

Day 4,5 - Sigiriya

Next, travel to Sigiriya and check into a hotel, renowned for its proud history. Visit Minneriya National Park, located about a 45-minute drive away, to observe wild Asian elephants. Drive through herds of majestic elephants and observe them in their natural habitat. This unforgettable experience will leave you in awe of these magnificent creatures and the park's stunning scenery. During your walk, you'll have the opportunity to explore the vibrant local market and bustling clothing bazaar. In addition, you'll encounter several

fascinating colonial-era landmarks, Hotels built in colonial era, the historic Nuwara Eliya Post Office, the prestigious Hill Club.

Day 9 - Nuwareliya to Ella
