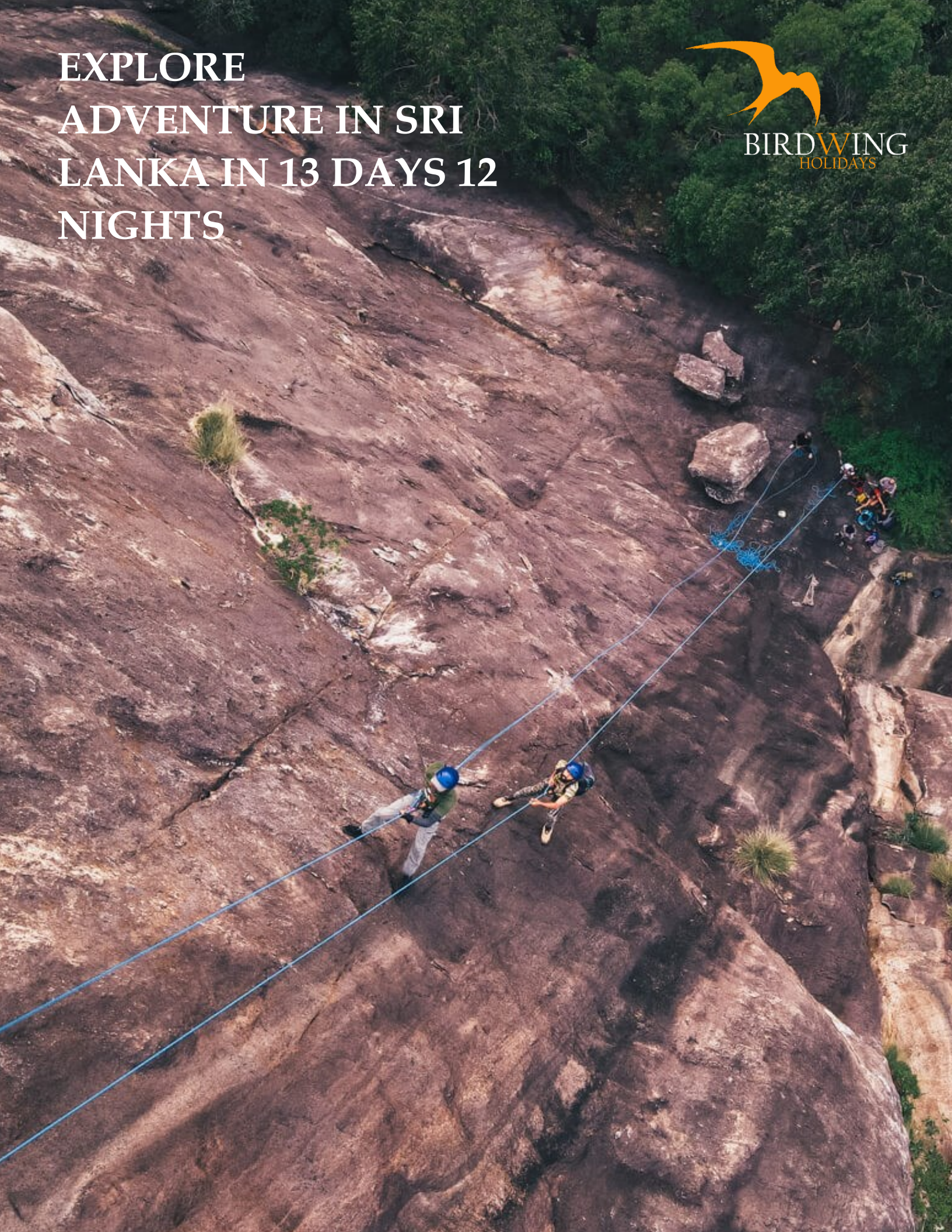

His passion for the region, combined with generous support and funding from the European Union (EU) and additional assistance from the United States Agency for International Development (USAID), brought this extraordinary trail to life. The Pekoe Trail invites travelers to embark on a unique journey, discovering Sri Lanka's hidden gems by foot and connecting with the heart and soul of the island.
