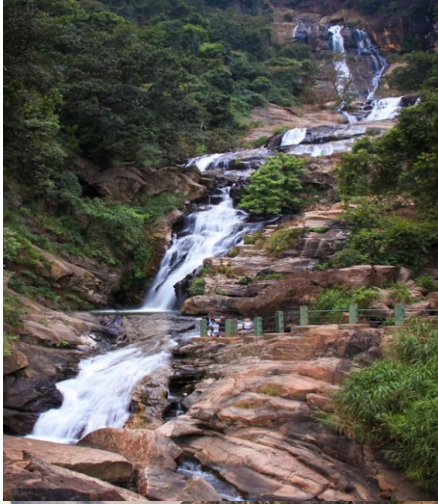


# Family Tour In Sri Lanka

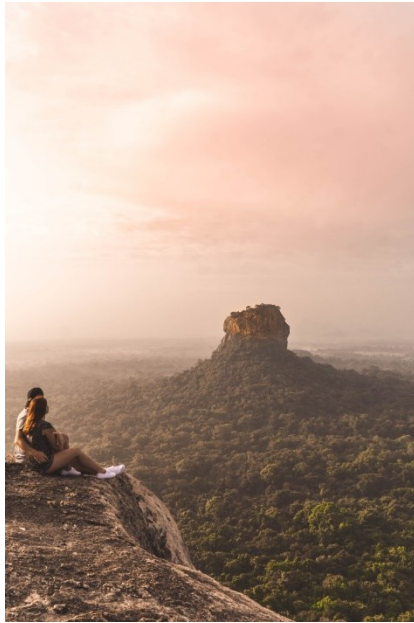
## Day 4-5: Sigiriya – Historical Marvels

On day 5, Visit the ancient rock fortress, often referred to as the Eighth Wonder of the World, and marvel at its architectural ingenuity. After that visit Anuradhapura ancient city full of marvelous architectural monuments and sculptures allied with buddhism

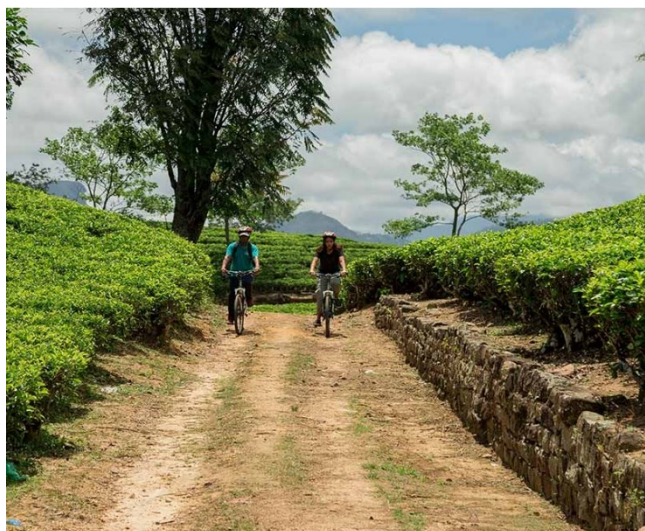




## Day 7-8: Hatton – Tea Trails

The hill country is rich in biodiversity, with tea plantations interspersed with forest patches that are home to endemic species, from amphibians to birds and leopards. These trails can be self-guided, or guests can opt to be accompanied by a guide for a deeper understanding of the region's history and biodiversity.
